Waiting to see if the state will issue bonds for student housing. There is construction on the Valencia campus. Will be opening the Natural and Health Science Building at the Canyon Country campus. Cal-Grant Application deadline has been extended to Thursday, May 2. Will hold their Community Resource Fair at the Valencia campus.

Newhall

Just did polling for a bond measure and are waiting for results. Received their proposition 28 funds and hired three new music teachers and two art teachers. Have 5,922 students enrolled. Partnered with the Raising the Curtain Foundation to support the arts.
