School Year 2024-2025

We are excited to participate in your child's growth and learning next year. At Meadows we are proud of the level of support parents provide to our school programs. One simple way parents have helped out is by providing some basic supplies. For the next school year there are two types of supplies we are asking you to donate. First are the personal supplies for your child which should be brought on the first day of school. Please be sure your child's name is written on everything. The second donation of supplies we are asking for should be brought to Back to School Night. These supplies are for general classroom use by the teacher, students, and other support personnel and volunteers. We are giving you this list now so your family has the option of taking advantage of back-to-school sales that traditionally take place in early August.

On the first day of school each student may bring the following labeled with their name whenever possible: (No rolling backpacks or 3 ring binders please.)

- ✓ 1 Durable two-pocket folder for homework
- ✓ 1 three-prong folder for their data folder
- ✓ 3 single subject spiral notebooks (*100 pages or more each*) for math, writing, and ELA
- ✓ 1 Composition Book
- ✓ Pencils
- ✓ 1 set of colored pencils
- ✓ 1 package of crayons
- ✓ Thin-tip markers
- ✓ 1 small scissor
- ✓ 1 bottle of school glue
- ✓ 1 pencil pouch or pencil box
- ✓ 1 book cover
- ✓ 1-2 large erasers
- ✓ Dry erase markers and eraser
- ✓ 1 pack of ultra-fine Sharpies
- ✓ **Wired Headphones (no Bluetooth)- in gallon bag labeled with name**

At Back to School Night we would appreciate donations of the following items for the classroom

- ✓ Boxes /Cases of Facial Tissue
- ✓ Baby Wipes
- ✓ Black Sharpies –fine and ultra fine or Flair fine tip pens (black only)
- ✓ Mr. Sketch scented markers
- ✓ Post its – various sizes
- ✓ Anti-bacterial wipes (for desks)

Supply support is appreciated throughout the year. If you are able to provide extra materials for students who may not be able to purchase their own, please send those extra supplies to the classroom teacher. Items like dry erase markers, pencils, and facial tissues (especially during the cold season and allergy season) are frequently needed.
