FACILITIES, MAINTENANCE, & OPERATIONS WERE BUSY OVER THE SUMMER

Summer is the busiest time for our Facilities, Maintenance & Operations, Technology, and custodial staff. Several projects were completed throughout the District, including:

- New heating ventilation, and, air conditioning (“HVAC”) systems installed at Old Orchard and Stevenson Ranch
- SmartBoards replaced throughout the District
- Annual routine fire alarm, fire sprinkler, fire extinguisher and playground inspections were completed
- Asphalt repairs were completed at Pico Canyon
- Tree trimming completed at McGrath, Newhall, Stevenson Ranch, Wiley Canyon, and the District Office
- Exterior door painting completed at Stevenson Ranch and Wiley Canyon
- All site flooring was stripped and waxed

The department has several other projects in various stages of completion, including

- Replacement of network access points to improve internet access throughout the District
- Completion of designs for new audio/visual systems in all MPRs. The next step is to go out to bid for installation of the systems
- Access control and CCTV upgrades are in progress for the ten schools. The project will include a new key card system for doors and a video security system
- Old Orchard’s field fence will be extended to expand the field area for student play

Two new playgrounds are bringing joy to students at the Newhall and Peachland Preschools. Returning students were excited to see the transformation to their favorite area on campus! The addition of a new inclusive accessible playground at the Peachland Preschool is the first all-accessible playground in the District. The playground is designed to allow children of all abilities to play together, promoting health and wellness through memorable experiences.


Awards & Recognitions!
